This is a new award-winning film about an historic 1975 UFO event. Seven loggers encounter a craft of unknown origin in the Sitgreaves National Forest.

One of the crew, Travis Walton, goes missing, igniting a firestorm of controversy lasting 40 years.



TRAVIS combines new and archived interviews with the logging crew, police, and the polygraph examiner.

Walton explains why the forest, the highway, and the phone booth remain emotional triggers.

Fifteen experts, including nuclear physicist Stanton Friedman, former FBI agent Ben Hansen, and Huffington Post journalist Lee Speigel explain why this story continues to astound investigators, researchers, scientists, journalists, and filmmakers in their quest for reliable evidence of other worlds, other beings, and more advanced technologies.

Paramount pictures fictionalized this story in their successful 1993 movie, *Fire the Sky*, based on Travis Walton's book by the same name. The true story had never been fully told until now, as Travis guides us through his amazing, terrifying journey.

Viewers uninterested in the UFO topic are astonished by the first-hand accounts from the loggers and the human side of the story.

Forty years of history come to life when the five living loggers and police recount the impact this event continues to have on their lives today.

UFO experts show how this event has profound impact on both our everevolving human consciousness and the evolution of our species.

This fast-paced sci-fi style investigative treatment keeps viewers on the edge of their seats as it reveals how for decades ridicule has prevented serious investigation of the UFO phenomena.

The 90-minute film *Travis: The True Story of Travis Walton*, debuted in February, 2015 and to date has won 27 "Official Selections" at film festivals.

This newly-edited 80-minute documentary includes new archived footage, more in-depth interviews and additional tree ring research.

Jennifer W. Stein, director and executive producer began this project in 2013 to commemorate the 40th anniversary of this historic UFO event, capturing personal testimonies on camera, offering a new perspective for an amazing story.

Key participants include: crew members Travis Walton, Mike Rogers, Ken Peterson, Steve Pierce, John Goulette, Arizona state polygraph examiner, Cy Gilson, police sheriffs Marlin Gillespie and Deputy Ellison, Huffington Post Journalist Lee Speigel, authors Peter Robbins, Stanton Friedman, Kathleen Marden, Richard Dolan, David Jacobs, Ph. D., Leo Sprinkle Ph. D., and filmmaker James Fox, with a special appearance from host of SyFy's *Fact or Faked*, former FBI agent Ben Hansen.

Each interview supports the case for compelling evidence that we are not alone in the universe. While the film does not attempt to prove the existence of other intelligent life forms, it instead delves into the hearts and minds of the crew, first responders, and serious researchers as they reveal the impact this event has had on their lives. Travis Walton especially, explains the new insights 40 years have given him since that frightful day November 5, 1975.

Facing a significant deadline—the 40th anniversary (2015), an amazing combination of crew and volunteers offered their time, talent and services to capture these personal testimonies.

The logging crew returned to the original locations, where CGI, drone equipment and gorilla filmmaking techniques helped to capture their stories. New discoveries emerged in the process.

TRAVIS: The True story of Travis Walton has been screened at more than 30 special events, conferences, and lectures, featuring personal appearances of Travis Walton, the logging crew and film crew. This film continues to serve as an anchor for ongoing anniversary gatherings around the world.

TRAVIS has earned 27 official selections at mainstream film festivals around the U.S., winning six additional outstanding awards of recognition, and has screened in six countries by special invitation.
